In partnership with UNICEF South Sudan, Eve Organization is looking for enthused and fervent individuals from Yambio to implement its access to GBV services for women and girls project in Yambio, Western Equatoria State.

### Post Description

Under the overall supervision of the GBV Manager, the Social Worker (SW) will supervise the Women and Girls' friendly spaces (WGFs) and be responsible for the provision of quality case management including implementation of all psychosocial activities in targeted schools and communities. With direct supervision from with the GBV Officers, the SW will support in the provision of training and supervising GBV Community Outreach Staff to respond to cases of GBV in the communities and ensure effective case management. This includes providing training and mentorship and utilizing monitoring and evaluation systems to ensure high quality services.

The SW will directly contribute to successful implementation of the access to GBV services for women and girls project in Yambio, Western Equatoria State.

### Key Responsibilities

#### Case Management and Training

- Provide professional and confidential services to survivors of GBV, grounded in Eve's holistic, survivor-centered case management approach
- Document client information through accurate filling of intake forms and ensure confidential and safe storage
- Support the maintenance of the Eve's case management system by maintaining client confidentiality and ensure the GBViMS is accurately updated on a regular basis
- Ethically and confidentially collect and store GBV data
- Participate in the development of case management monitoring systems and help to ensure that GBV community outreach staff utilize these systems correctly and consistently.
- Participate in preparation of all relevant reports regarding the eve's psychosocial activities.
- Provide leadership and guidance regarding psychosocial activities to all community outreach staff to ensure all programme activities meet best practice standards.
- Monitor and supervise case management, including capacity building of all community outreach staff through training.



### ***Coordination and Networking***

- Strengthen and maintain networks with community leaders, women leaders, other available service providers to ensure that survivors receive compassionate support from the community and to encourage greater communication, collaboration and coordination among partners (Nutrition, health, WASH, Education and legal sectors)
- Monitor community outreach plan with community outreach staff, based on case trends and ongoing needs of women and girls
- Work in collaboration with GBV outreach staff to ensure ongoing needs of women and girls are being met through prevention-related activities.

### ***Others***

- Fulfill any other duties and responsibilities as assigned
- Respect the code of conduct and policies of Eve Organization and the standards of the GBV team
- Adhere and uphold the Eve's principles (integrity, transparency, accountability and confidentiality) at the respective areas of work

### ***Qualifications***

- University degree/Diploma in counseling and/or psychology, Social Science, Community Studies, Education or related degree
- Minimum 2 years of direct psychosocial/counseling and case management experience with a reputable agency; experience working with survivors of violence preferred.
- MUST have some knowledge on GBV and responding to GBV in emergency settings – and demonstrate understanding of a survivor-centered approach.
- Must have a good communication and community mobilization skills
- Must be willing to work in a hardship, rural environment
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in English with intermediate proficiency of Azande and Arabic is desired

### ***Standards of Professional Conduct***
